

REGISTRATION

Summer Camp Registration can be completed online or in-person. You may reserve a space for your child by paying the full camp fee or with a nonrefundable deposit for each week of camp. Payments on May 15, June 15, and July 15 will be automatically charged to the credit/debit card on file unless alternative arrangements are made.

In order to ensure the safety of all campers we have placed a deadline for registration. Online registration will end the Wednesday prior to the start of the camp week. In person registration will be taken up to 12:00 p.m. Thursday prior to start of camp week. No weekend registrations will be accepted.

* Week 1 pricing will apply due to July 4 holiday

EARLY BIRD FEES & PRICING

Early Bird pricing applies to registrations received up to May 1. Registration received after May 1 will be subject to regular pricing.

CAMP DEPOSITS

A \$50 deposit is required for each week of camp (a \$200 deposit is required for The Young Explorers and the Adventurers Camps). Deposits are non-refundable, non-transferable and are not subject to any discounts, promotions or financial assistance.

REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS

All deposits are non-refundable. Camp fees may be refunded before May 1, 2016 at the discretion of the Camp Director. Refunds will be made in the same form that payment was made. No refunds will be provided if a child leaves camp early due to disruptive behavior, as determined by the Camp Director.

CAMP TRANSFERS

Camp families are allowed one transfer session per family at no cost. Thereafter, a \$30 fee for each transfer request will be applied.
