BUS TRANSPORTATION

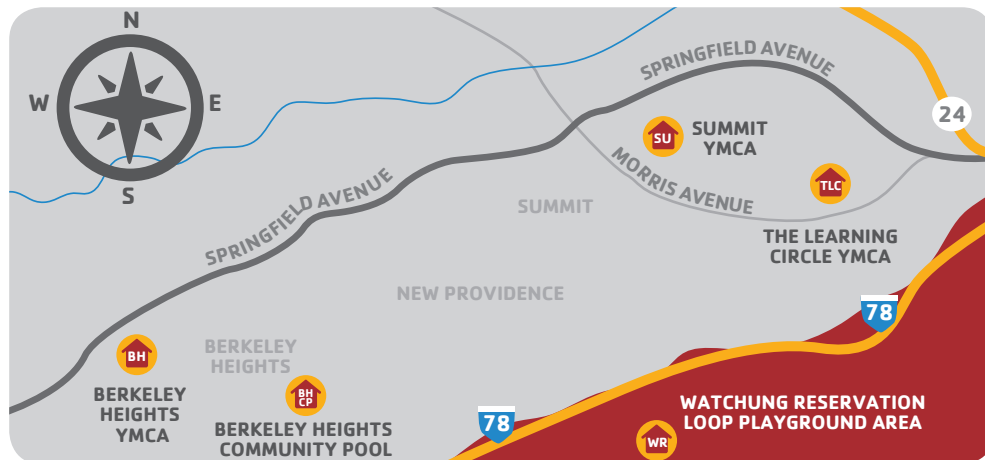

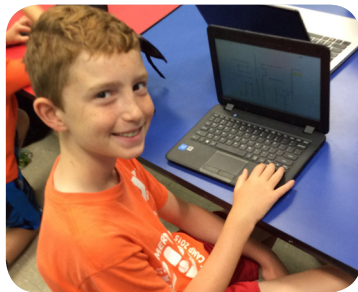
