Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language, or any type of menacing behavior. Physical contact with another person in an angry, aggressive, or threatening way. Verbally abusive behavior, including angry or vulgar language, swearing, name-calling, or shouting. Sexually explicit conversation or behavior; any sexual contact with another person. Inappropriate, immodest, or sexually revealing attire. Theft or behavior that results in the destruction or loss of property. Using or possessing alcohol or illegal chemicals on YMCA property or at YMCA-sponsored program Loitering within or on the grounds of the YMCA. Disregard of facility guidelines, including cell phone use in undesignated areas. Smoking on YMCA property - the YMCA and its property is a smoke-free environment. Children under the age of 13 must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times, and are prohibited from entering the fitness center area. Carrying or concealing a weapon or any device or object that may be used as a weapon. No one having been on any sexual offender list at any time may be a member of the Summit Area YMCA, participate in programs, be on the property or enter the facility.
