When you entrust your child to the Y, we strive to fulfill our promise to make each day an opportunity for us to partner with you to give your child a warm, personal, manageable learning experience. We aim to make our facility a **home-away-from-home**, and work closely with you to **individualize** your child's daily schedule and needs by working with their assigned primary caregiver. While primary caregivers are not the exclusive caregivers for your child, they are **responsible for keeping daily track of your child's day, supplies, and are your go-to contact** should you have questions or concerns. Your primary caregiver becomes an expert with regard to your child and is his/her advocate and coordinator at The Learning Circle YMCA.

Our caregivers develop monthly lesson plans to **identify emerging milestones** and design activities to encourage the development of age-appropriate skills. We progress your child through bottle feedings and strained foods and move them to table foods where we practice self-feeding.



We are mindful to provide guided play and tummy time for Infants so that the child can grow and develop at their own pace. Sleep schedules are specific to and determined by your child each day.

When it is time to move to the Toddler Program, your primary caregiver will oversee the transition to your child's new room and environment.

Children are introduced to new vocabulary to enhance their linguistic skills. Staff will use books, fingerplays, puppet shows and songs to increase language familiarity and skill.
