MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED

An active Summit Area YMCA (SAY) Membership is required to attend and register for our summer camps. If you do not have a SAY Family Membership, you may enroll your child as a Youth or Teen Member. Youth Memberships (0-12) are \$120/year. A Teen Membership (13-17) is \$60/month.

REGISTRATION

Our camp guide is interactive! Simply click on the camp you're interested to register or learn more. Detailed information can also be found by visiting www.thesay.org/camp.

As a benefit of Family Membership, SAY Family Members can save \$10 each week of camp when they sign up before January 19! Use promo code: FAMILY26

To ensure a safe and quality camp experience for all campers, online registration will end 10 days in advance of the start of the camp week. No registrations will be accepted the weekend before the camp week begins. If late registration is accepted, late registration fees do apply. Requests for late registrations must be submitted via the [Camp Registrar](#).

PAYMENT & DEPOSITS

You may reserve a space for your child by paying the full camp fee or with a non-refundable \$50 deposit for each week of camp or \$100 deposit for travel camps. Payments due June 1, June 15, July 1, and July 15 will automatically be charged to the credit/debit card on file unless alternative arrangements are made with the [Camp Registrar](#).

CANCELLATION POLICY

All deposits made at time of registration are non-refundable. Refunds requested before April 1, 2026 will be made in the same form as payment was made, less the deposit. No refunds will be given after April 1, 2026. All requests received less than 5 business days prior to camp session beginning will not be honored. If your child's camp is cancelled for some unforeseen reason a full refund will be given in the original form of payment. No refunds will be provided for the following: child's disruptive behavior as determined by Lead Camp staff, insufficient notice of family commitments, undocumented medical absences.
